#### LATEST NEWS FROM ROYAL MAIL

Please note Non-barcoded Definitive stamps will be phased out but will now remain usable until July 2023. Royal Mail is encouraging customers to find any non-barcoded stamps they have at home so they can use them up, unused stamps will be exchangeable under a 'Swap Out' scheme.

# **CALLING ALL STAMP EVENT ORGANISERS**

The new website of the ABPS provides the opportunity for organisers of philatelic events such as Stamp Fairs, Philatelic Exhibitions, Society Weekends and Regional Society Meetings, to promote their events free of charge. It is also a chance, if you are planning an event, to check that it does not clash with anything else.
